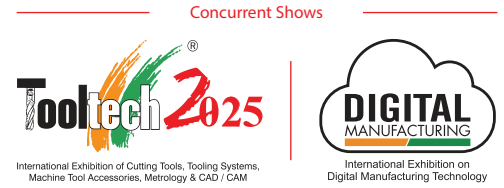

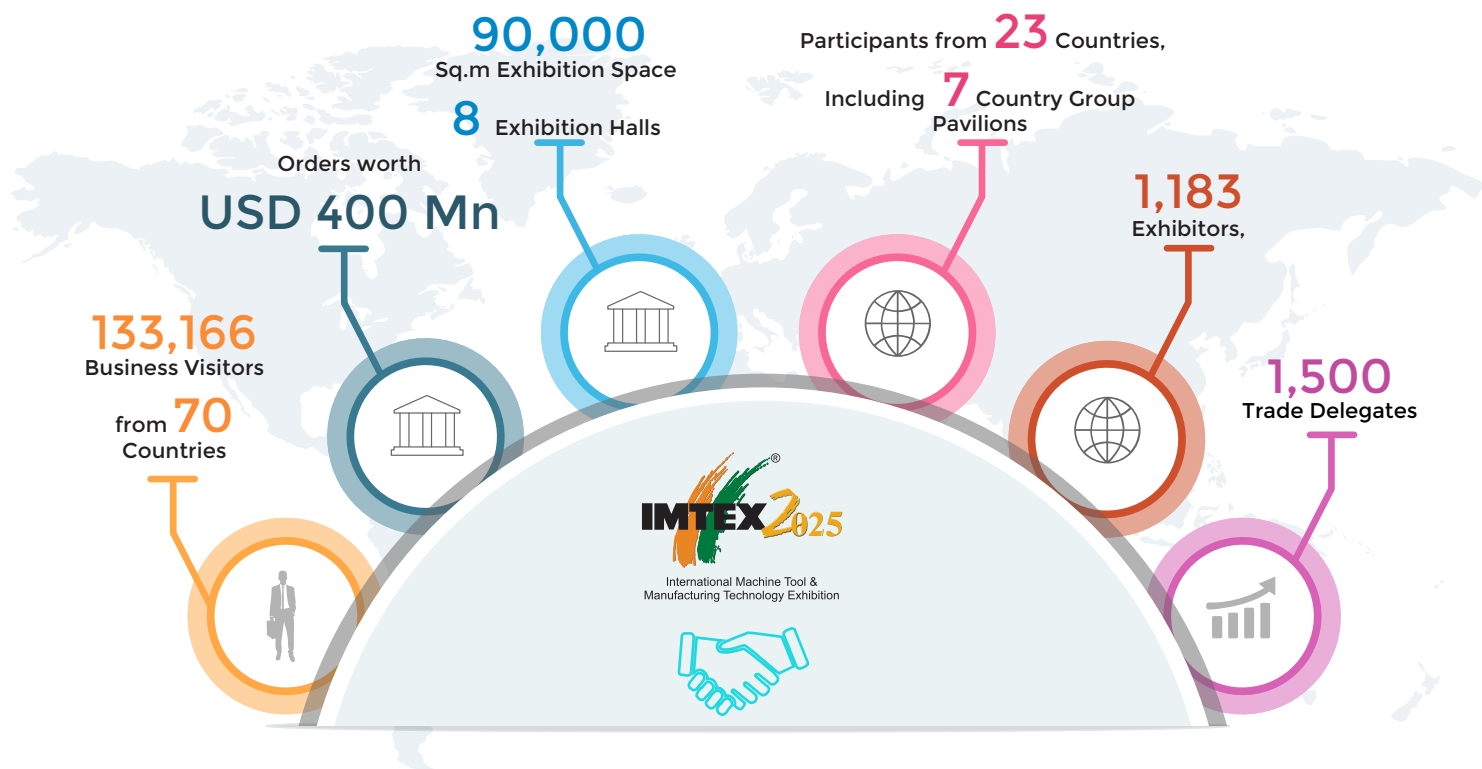

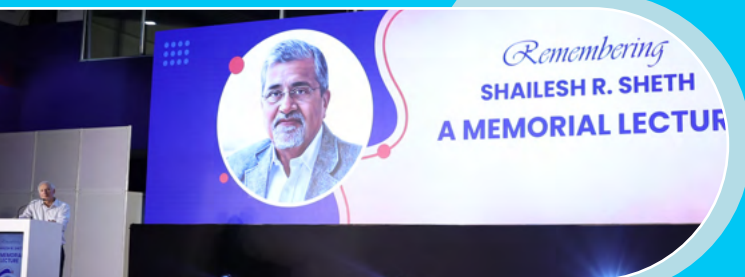
Machinery and Electrical Equipment Safety (Omnibus Technical Regulation) Order:

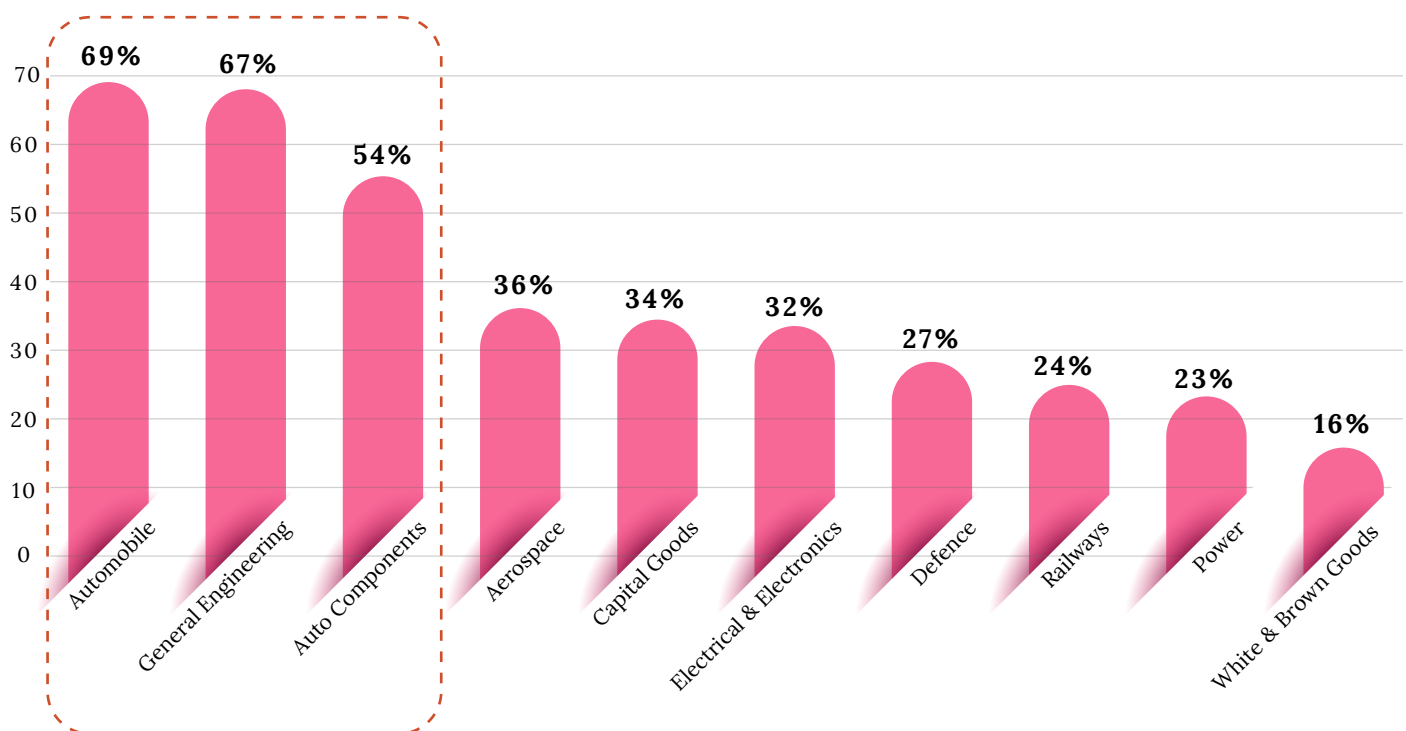

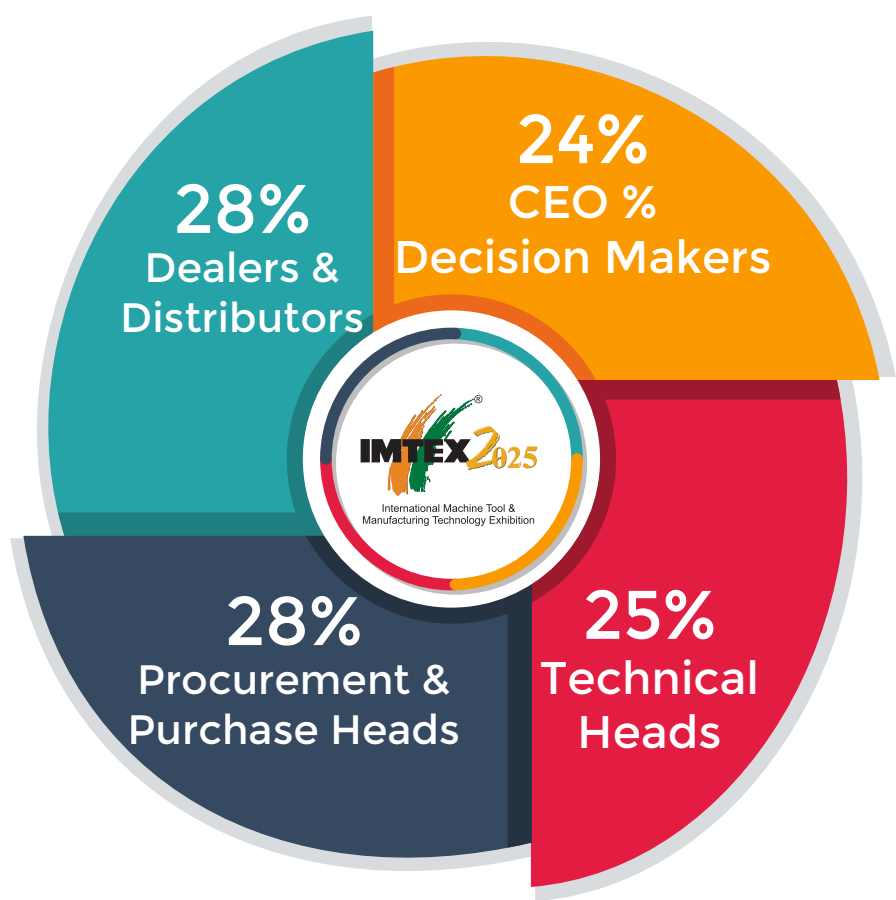
Industrial Segment of the Visitors
