IMTEX FORMING 2020 & TOOLTECH 2020 SUCCESS STORY!

The 6th edition of Asia's largest exhibition on metal forming, IMTEX FORMING 2020 & Tooltech 2020, organized by Indian Machine Tool Manufacturers' Association (IMTMA) concluded on 28th January 2020 on a positive note.

Overall, 605 exhibitors from 26 countries participated to get the best out of 'IMTEX FORMING 2020 & Tooltech 2020. The feedback from the exhibitors has been impressive and many were satisfied with the business orders and enquiries that they generated.

Visitors connected with latest innovations in 3D printing and Industry 4.0, exhibited in dedicated arenas.

IMTMA has undertaken several initiatives to enhance the exhibitor and visitor experiences which received positive responses. IMTEX FORMING & Tooltech 2020 recorded a footfall of 47,944 visitors which was a 33% increase compared to the previous edition.

Orders worth Rs.559 Crores and enquiries to the value of Rs.4,984 Crores were generated during the exhibition.




