





Making it happen

Indian Machine Tool Manufacturers' Association (IMTMA) flagship exhibition 'IMTEX 2017 & Tooltech 2017' held at the Bangalore International Exhibition Centre (BIEC) attracted a footfall of 75,440 visitors. Orders worth ₹ 1,670 Cr and enquiries to the value of ₹ 18,989 Cr were generated during the exhibition. Compared to IMTEX 2015 the booked orders have shown an increase of 16% whereas the generated enquiries increased by 21%.















Spread across 6 halls in a gross area of 66,000 square metres, IMTEX 2017 showcased evolving technologies such as Industry 4.0, hybrid machines, 3D printing, etc.

The exhibition witnessed participation from 601 Indian companies and 471 foreign companies. The participation came from 23 countries, including 7 group participations from China, Czech Republic, Germany, Italy, Japan, Spain, Taiwan and USA.











Inauguration






Overall satisfaction score from exhibitors and visitors




Visitors satisfaction on purpose of visit to IMTEX 2017




Percentage of Visitors Representing Various Industries @ IMTEX 2017
